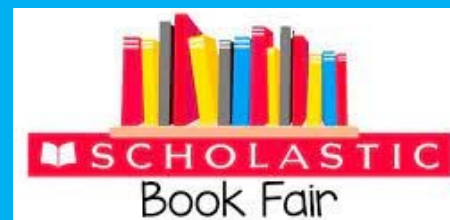

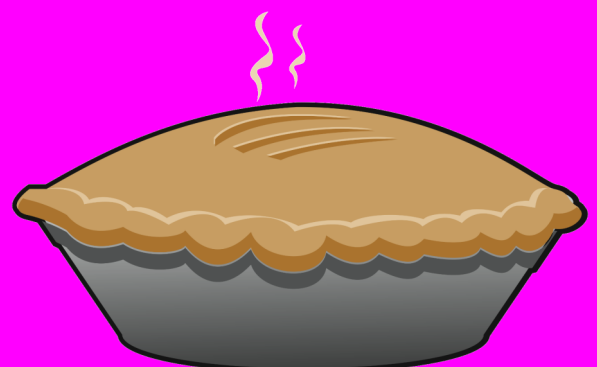


SEPS Parents & Friend's pie drive fundraiser

Term two will finish at 2:30pm on Friday 28th June.

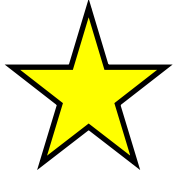
Ditto Show
